- No criminal record and no pending charges
- Valid British Columbia Drivers License and responsible driving history
- Physically fit, able to meet the physical component of training

- Good moral character
- Mature and responsible
- Capable of passing background investigation / security clearance
- Fully available to attend initial training and to meet program commitments
- Not ineligible for the Program due to conflict of interest

Who Should Apply?

Reserve Constables come from many different backgrounds. We especially encourage applications from:

- Students attending post-secondary institutions and considering a career in policing (many of our Reserve Constables have become Port Moody Police Officers)
- Civic-minded individuals with established careers who are interested in contributing to the safety of their community
- Individuals with knowledge of a second language or culture
- Residents of, and those with a connection to, Port Moody

Reserve Duties

Reserve Constables deliver crime prevention programs to citizens, assist with community events and displays, and participate in a ride-a-long program with police officers.

Reserve Constables wear a uniform similar to but distinctive from police officers. They do not carry firearms and do not replace police officers.

Program Benefits

As a Port Moody Reserve Constable, you will be part of an elite group of volunteers within the Port Moody Police Department. You will have the pride and satisfaction of knowing that you are making a significant contribution to public safety. Our Reserve Constables receive many benefits, including:

- **Professional training delivered by experienced police officers**
- **Exciting opportunities to assist with crime prevention and community programs**
- **Invaluable volunteer experience in a law enforcement environment**
- **Uniform, equipment and dry cleaning**
- **Worksafe coverage and AD&D insurance**

Commitment

After basic training, Reserve Constables are expected to volunteer at least 20 hours per month. We request a minimum two-year commitment after graduation.



Training

Candidates must complete the basic Reserve Constable Training mandated by the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General, consisting of more than 90 hours of classroom instruction and physical training, delivered two weekday evenings per week and occasional weekend days for 6 months.

Subjects covered include criminal law, crime prevention, traffic, professionalism, tactical communication and force options. There are strong academic and physical components. Following examinations by the instructors and by the Justice Institute of British Columbia, successful candidates are appointed as *Special Municipal Constables (Reserve Constable Program)*.
